TO IMPERATOR GALBA, ROME

All Hail Caesar
Greetings from Valerius Asiaticus [Governor Belgica]

News from the Rhine Frontier. The troops have been paid - just - and are much displeased due to the oversight of delayed payment. Many frontier towns were taxed directly and will no doubt be expecting payment of IOUs from the Treasury. Barbarians are quite restless and we need reinforcements before beginning a pacification campaign.

Your Imperial Highness

TO POMPEIUS VOPISCUS, SENATOR AT ROME

Greetings,
