You are the local chief of the Afghan National Police. You have a small police station in town along with a Lieutenant, Senior Sergeant, Sergeant and five patrolmen. They are all armed with pistols and AKs and there are two RPGs with an assortment of warheads. You also have 2 Ford Ranger patrol vehicles, one of which you have claimed exclusive use of (along with a patrolman driver).

Although you are not local you are of the majority Gilzhai branch of the Pashtun tribe, like most of the people around here. Your men are all from other districts but you are sure of their loyalty, in particular the Lt and Sergeants as, like you, they paid for their promotions.

Your land is a war-zone. You want this to end at the earliest possible time, ideally without any loss to your people. In fact there might well be some way that you can profit from the chaos and the reconstruction and aid budgets of the foreigners helping your national government. However, you need to remember that you will continue to live here with the people once the foreigners have gone home, and you need to make sure that you avoid making enemies of those that will also remain here as much as possible. If you do make some enemies, then you need to either make amends, or get some powerful allies.

- Stay alive, and keep your men alive too
- keep your position as chief of police
- Be seen to enforce law and order
- be pious and well respected in the community
